1. Any perspective member must make 3 meetings expressing their interest in the Squad. These meetings must be within a 60 day period.
2. A perspective member must complete an application prior to being voted on – unless one has not been made available to you.
3. All members of the Bledsoe County Rescue Squad must meet the guidelines listed below:

Training Attendance	50%
Fundraiser Attendance	25%
Mission Response	25%

The meeting on the 1st Tuesday is a regular business meeting, the 3rd Tuesday is training/work detail meeting. The Captain has the right to call any special meetings at his own discretion and time. All special call meetings will be announced on the Emergency Radio by E911 Central Dispatch.
